As we continue in our Year of Mary, June focuses on the Mary's love for us all, especially those who are troubled or persecuted in some way. As next week is 'Refugee Week' we are asking the children and their families to pray for people in war zones or those who are refugees because they are escaping persecution. This year's theme is 'Compassion' and what this looks like in action. Together we can create a shared understanding of compassion to ensure we are extending it widely to all. Today, the children will be bringing home a heart prayer card (see below), we would like to invite families to write a short message on the heart so that we can add it to our Prayer Tree in school.



As such, next week we are inviting the children to show how arts and culture can help widen our circle of compassion. The children will take part in simple acts throughout the week, being part of a movement of people everywhere taking small steps to create a big change. #### **Year 4 Transition**

As part of the year 4 transition to St. Joseph's Middle School, Mrs. Eleanor Stoves (transition Lead) will be coming into St. Mary's to talk to the Year 4 students who will be transferring up to St. Joseph's in the summer. Mrs. Stoves will provide pupils with a transition booklet, during her visit to St. Mary's the children will go through the booklet with Mrs. Stoves, who will also show them an example of the St. Joseph's planner.

Following the pupil visit St. Joseph's on the 16<sup>th</sup>, there is a rounders afternoon arranged for Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Pupils will return to St. Mary's before the end of the school day and will be dismissed from school as usual. Please note that HMS rounders afternoon is also on the 28<sup>th</sup> June, parents may collect any children transferring to HMS from school at 1pm so they can attend this event.

Please can we advise parents check the weather forecast before school and ensure children have sun cream applied before attending school. Please could children be provided with a hat or cap and a water bottle throughout the summer term.

Please note that we <u>no longer use Weduc</u>, all consents and payments for trips and visits will be sent through Arbor. You won't receive in app messages/newsletters as this will send straight to your email.

For those who haven't yet downloaded the Arbor app, you have been sent an email with your log in details. This was sent by the Arbor team 22<sup>nd</sup> May.

Just a reminder, please give school one week's notice if you wish to change the meal pattern for your child.

#### **Trip Payments**

Y3 & Y4 - Tyne Theatre Trip - All payments due by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June.

Y1 & Y2 Beamish Museum – All payments are made on the Arbor and are due by 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

#### Hall Hill Farm

Reception will be visiting Hall Hill Farm on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June as part of their Understanding the World curriculum. The children will be leaving school at 9:15am and returning no later than 3pm, traffic permitting. The cost of the trip is £16.10 per child, which covers the admission into the farm and the cost of the coach. Payments for the trip are payable via ARBOR.

#### **Beamish**

Year 1 and 2 will be visiting Beamish on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July as part of their History curriculum. The children will be leaving school at 9.15am. The cost of the trip is £16.10 per child, covering admission, a workshop and the cost of the coach. In their workshop, children will learn all about what life was like as a Victorian School Child including playing traditional playground games and taking part in a traditional lesson. The children will need with a packed lunch (school will provide a lunch for those in receipt of free school meals), water bottle, hat/cap and suncream. There will be an opportunity for children to visit the gift shop so if you would like, your child can bring a small amount of pocket money-no more than £5. Payments for the trip are payable by ARBOR. Please could all payments be made no later than 3<sup>rd</sup> July. Please contact the office if you have any queries.

#### KS2 fun day

In addition to visiting the theatre to watch a performance of 'Rewilding Dreams' on the 7th of July, we also are organising a 'fun day' for KS2 which will involve a picnic in the park and an ice-cream! There will be more information to follow!
