Just a reminder, please give school one week's notice if you wish to change the meal pattern for your child.

#### **Trip Payments**

#### **Hall Hill Farm**

Reception will be visiting Hall Hill Farm on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June as part of their Understanding the World curriculum. The children will be leaving school at 9:15am and returning no later than 3pm, traffic permitting. The cost of the trip is £16.10 per child, which covers the admission into the farm and the cost of the coach. Payments for the trip are payable via ARBOR.

School will be providing a packed lunch for all pupils attending, but advise children to bring their own water bottle. Children should wear comfortable trousers such jogging bottoms and their normal school uniform on the top. Children will require sensible footwear. Please can all children have sun cream applied before school and bring a hat/cap and waterproof with them for the trip.

#### **Beamish**

Year 1 and 2 will be visiting Beamish on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July as part of their History curriculum. The children will be leaving school at 9.15am. The cost of the trip is £16.10 per child, covering admission, a workshop and the cost of the coach. In their workshop, children will learn all about what life was like as a Victorian School Child including playing traditional playground games and taking part in a traditional lesson. The children will need with a packed lunch (school will provide a lunch for those in receipt of free school meals), water bottle, hat/cap and suncream. There will be an opportunity for children to visit the gift shop so if you would like, your child can bring a small amount of pocket money-**no more than £5**. Payments for the trip are payable by ARBOR. Please could all payments be made no later than 3<sup>rd</sup> July. Please contact the office if you have any queries.

#### KS2 fun day

Following the theatre visit on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July to watch a performance of 'Rewilding Dreams', we have also organised a 'fun day' for KS2 which will involve a picnic in the park with an ice-cream, before heading to the Wentworth to go bowling. There will be a small cost of £4 per child and payments can be made using Arbor. This trip was originally organised to go ahead on the 7<sup>th</sup> July, due to the teacher's strike we have rearranged this trip to take place on the 13<sup>th</sup> July instead.

Payments have now gone live for the Y3 & Y4 bowling trip, please can all payments be paid by Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

#### **Sports Day**

Sports day will take place on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> July. Parents are invited to support and take part from 9.15am - finish (approximately 11.45am). Please send your child to school wearing their **school PE kit** that day wearing suncream, sunhat and a big bottle of water.

The PTA will be selling refreshments & snacks on the day. They are also collecting prizes for the raffle that will be drawn at the end. Bring any donations to the school office. The PTA are hoping to sell school uniform too, and request that parents bring cash for these items.
