#### KS2 Theatre Trip

As years 3 and 4 are visiting the theatre on Monday afternoon, they do not require their PE kit or swimming kit on Monday. All children should attend school On Monday wearing their school uniform.

#### Transfer Day

On Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July it is Transfer Day in the Hexham Partnership. Pupils in year 4 will be attending their new middle school on Tuesday and will be dropped off and collected from middle school that day. The rest of the children will spend time in their new classroom, with their new teacher on Transfer Day.

#### **Beamish**

Year 1 and 2 will be visiting Beamish on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July as part of their history curriculum. The children will be leaving school at 9.15am. The cost of the trip is £16.10 per child, covering admission, a workshop, and the cost of the coach. In their workshop, children will learn all about what life was like as a Victorian School Child including playing traditional playground games and taking part in a traditional lesson. The children will need with a packed lunch (school will provide a lunch for all children), water bottle, hat/cap and suncream. There will be an opportunity for children to visit the gift shop so if you would like, your child can bring a small amount of pocket money-no more than £5. Payments for the trip are payable by ARBOR. Please could all payments be made no later than 3<sup>rd</sup> July. Please contact the office if you have any queries.

#### KS2 fun day (Y3&Y4)

Following the theatre visit on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July to watch a performance of 'Rewilding Dreams', we have also organised a 'fun day' for KS2 which will involve a picnic in the park with an ice-cream, before heading to the Wentworth to go bowling. There will be a small cost of £4 per child and payments can be made using Arbor. This trip was originally organised to go ahead on the 7<sup>th</sup> July, due to the teacher's strike we have rearranged this trip to take place on the 13<sup>th</sup> July instead.

Payments have now gone live for the Y3 & Y4 bowling trip, please can all payments be paid by Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

#### <u>Weather</u>

The weather has been rather variable of late. We have been fortunate enough to have been blessed with warmer weather but do experience unexpected downpours on occasion. Please can we advise parents check the weather forecast before school and ensure children have sun cream applied before attending school and bring a waterproof, as children do continue to play outdoors if it is drizzling. Please can we also ask that children are provided with a hat or cap and a water bottle throughout the summer term.

#### <u>Arbor</u>

Please note that we <u>no longer use Weduc</u>, all consents and payments for trips and visits will be sent through Arbor. You won't receive in app messages/newsletters as this will send straight to your email.

For those who haven't yet downloaded the Arbor app, you have been sent an email with your log in details. This was sent by the Arbor team 22<sup>nd</sup> May.

Just a reminder, please give school one week's notice if you wish to change the meal pattern for your child.
