


St Mary's Catholic First School Newsletter – Friday 10th November 2023

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Tuesday key stage 2 visited the 'Museum of the Moon' exhibition at Hexham Abbey where the children took part in a storytelling journey about our cosmic companion, The Moon. How and when was it formed and why it orbits the Earth and how this affects us. The children discovered our relationship with the Moon and how this was changed by the NASA Apollo missions of the 1960's. They learnt about what our future relationship with the Moon will be like, with the commencement of the NASA Artemis missions and who might be the next

person to walk there!



Today, we had artist Deni Riach in from the Queen's Hall supporting year 3 in creating lanterns for the Lantern Parade, a free event that takes place on Friday 17th November at Hexham Bandstand. The children can't wait to illuminate their lanterns at this event.
