Dear Parents and Carers,

It was fantastic to see so many parents in school this week taking the opportunity to look at the children's books and discuss with their child(ren) the progress they have made this term.



Tynedale Hospice are holding their annual 'Light Up a Life' remembrance service at St. Mary's Catholic Church at 3pm on Saturday 2nd December. This service offers a chance for everyone to come together and remember loved ones no longer with us. People from all faiths are welcome, whether or not you or your loved one have ever received care from Tynedale Hospice. Please feel free to join in with this beautiful and uplifting service. Today in school, every child has written or drawn on a silver star anyone they would like to remember as we approach this Advent season. We are hanging the stars in our foyer throughout Advent. Tonight, each child will be bringing home another silver star, on the back of the star, we invite families to write down anyone they would like to remember this Advent. It would be lovely if the children could return the star to school next week to join the children's stars already on the tree.

As we are now in our Advent season the children will have the opportunity to take home 'The Travelling Nativity' for the night. Inside the bag that the children take home there will be several items including a candle, a story of the first Nativity, purple cloth, a crib and a book called 'Tales of the Travelling Nativity'. The idea is to help us remember the journey Mary & Joseph made to Bethlehem, and as a family to take time together to think about the true meaning of Christmas. The children will be able to set up the crib and take a few moments to reflect on what Christmas means to them, before writing or drawing a picture about the night the Travelling Nativity was in their home. For families with multiple siblings at St. Mary's, it will be the youngest sibling that will take the Travelling Nativity home to share with the family. In school, we look forward to sharing the 'Tales of the Travelling Nativity' with the class each day!

Christmas Jumper Day

On Friday 8th December, children can come to school wearing their school uniform, exchanging their usual school jumper/cardigan for a Christmas jumper if they wish. As the children also take part in a Santa Dash funrun that day, we also recommend that children in key stage 2 attend school wearing their school PE kit, plus their Christmas jumper. For Reception and Key Stage 1 who retain their PE kit in school, we suggest they come to school in school uniform and change into their PE kit at school. **If anyone has donations of pre-loved Christmas jumpers that they would like to donate to other children in school, then please deliver these to the main school office.** Children will also be permitted to wear their Christmas jumper during our Christmas lunch day (13th December). **If possible, can children also bring in £1 donation for the charity 'Save the Children'.**

Christmas Cinema Trip

A payment of £6.50 has now been set up on the Arbor App for the Arthur Christmas movie. **The payment deadline is Monday 11th December at 7pm.** Please pay before this date to ensure your child(ren)s place on the trip.

Christmas Pantomime

On Wednesday 20th December at 1:30pm the whole school will be visiting the Queen's Hall in Hexham to watch the performance of Snow White. A payment of £10 has now been set up on the Arbor App, the deadline for this trip is on Monday 18th December.

Christmas Lunch

On Wednesday 13th December we are having our school Christmas lunch in school. Children who are not usually on school dinners will be permitted to purchase this meal for the one day, whilst remaining on packed lunch for the rest of the week. **If your child is usually on packed lunch but wishes to have a Christmas dinner, please let the office know as soon as possible, before Wednesday 29th November.** Children are permitted to wear their school uniform, exchanging their usual school jumper/cardigan for a Christmas jumper on this day if they wish.

Open Art Afternoon

On Wednesday 13th December we would like to invite all parents/carers into school from 2:00-2:45pm to join your child(ren) in making some festive artwork. The children (& parents) really enjoy spending this time together in school, working together on a creative project. From 2:45-3:15pm while the children are finishing and tidying up, parents are welcome to have a catch up and a festive treat in the school hall, having a go at making your own Christingle (in preparation for our Christingle service the following day), while waiting for the children at the end of the day. **If parents/carers can bring an orange for making the Christingle, school will provide the rest!**

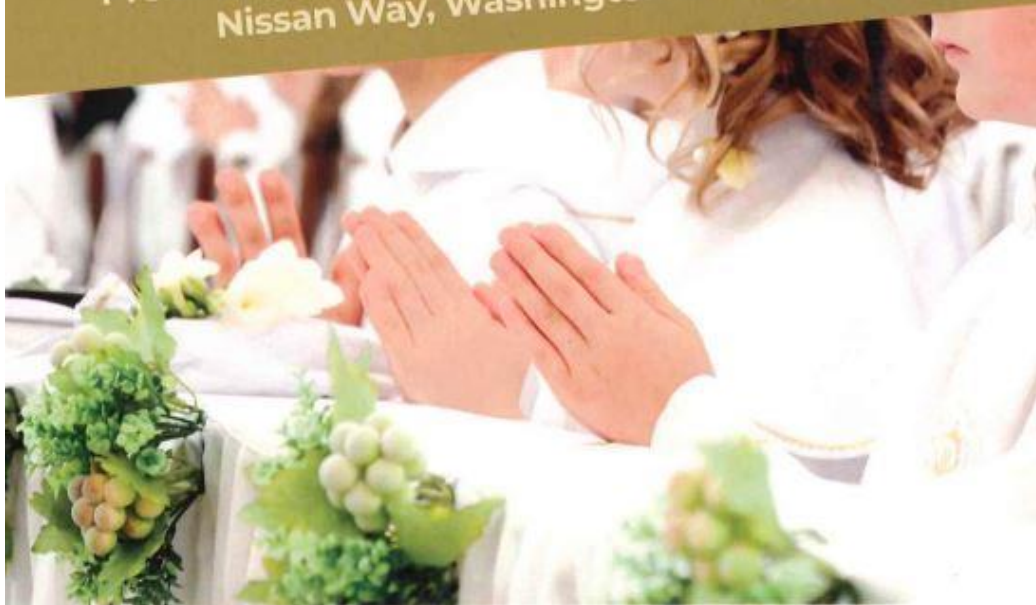
