Maya Civilisation



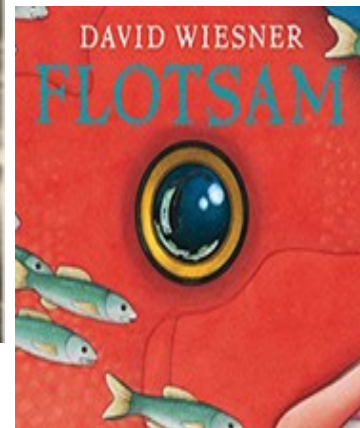
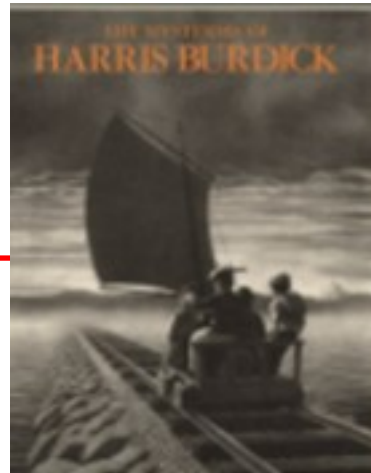
Have a debate about the mystery of the Mayans— present theories on why the Mayas deserted their cities
